Sub: Academic Cell/Bridge course for 2022-23 admitted students in core subjects - timelines/instructions issued - regarding.

As per the proceedings of the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Mangalagiri, and with the conclusion of the nine-day Student Induction Program (SIP- Deeksharambh), a 10 hour bridge course is to be offered to the newly admitted students to help them understand what they learnt and understood in the previous year of study (in the qualifying examination) and to expose them to the next year's academic curricula.

In this context, all the departments are requested to follow the guidelines furnished underneath.

- The course shall be transacted in a maximum of 10 hours and shall be conducted from 3 November 2022 to 15 November 2022 @ 1 hour a day to each core subject and regular curricula shall be transacted from 16 November 2022 as per the Semester Curricular Plans and Daily Scheduling. (CSPs and DSs shall get approved and circulated to students by 15 Nov '2022).
- The Bridge course shall be offered only in three core subjects (Science & Humanities) and in all core subjects of Commerce.
- The Departments shall segregate the students, frame daily time table and conduct classes.
- The attendance of the students in each session should be taken in the register.
- An examination for 50 marks shall be conducted by the departments between 16th and 17th November 2022.
- Performance evaluation of students in the examination shall be done and marks shall be posted in the departmental marks register by 20 November 2022.
- The students who secure below 40% shall be identified as slow learner, 40-70% as moderate learner and above 70% shall be identified as advanced learner and lists of the three category students, subject-wise shall be submitted to the Academic cell by 22 November 2022.
- The Academic Cell shall monitor the activity effectively.
