MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into on

20-8-2024

BETWEEN

PITHAPUR RAJAH'S GOVERNMENT COLLEGE (AUTONOMOUS), KAKINADA-533001, AP represented through THE PRINCIPAL (hereafter referred to as PRGC (A) or FIRST PARTY which shall unless repugnant to the context there of shall remain and include its successors, legal representatives and assignees)

AND

INDIAN RED CROSS SOCIETY, KAKINADA represented through its Secretary Sri K.Siva Kumar (hereafter referred to as Indian Red Cross, Kakinada or SECOND PARTY which shall unless repugnant to the context there of shall remain and include its successors, legal representatives and assignees)

Whereas the **FIRST PARTY** and **SECOND PARTY** are desirous of entering into an agreement whereby both the parties will be supporting with their resources to extension activities facilitating the host organization/institution's acceptance to extend help to conduct Blood donation camp, blood grouping, medical camp, create awareness on first aid and disaster management on the terms and conditions herein agreed to

SCOPE

1) Both the parties **FIRST PARTY** and **SECOND PARTY** aim to be in the mission of the Indian Red Cross Society i.e. to inspire, encourage and initiate at all times, all forms of humanitarian activities so the human suffering can be minimized, alleviated and even prevented, and thus contribute to creating a more congenial atmosphere for peace and develop empathy and concern for the society among the students. By this the **FIRST PARTY** achieves one of its missions as well i.e. turning the students into a wholesome personality.

2. Indian Red Cross Society, Kakinada will provide equipped free ambulance to conduct medical checkups during blood donation camps.

3. Indian Red Cross will conduct free health awareness talks by various specialists and organize periodical health checkup (Height, Weight, BP, Pulse and general examination) camps at least once in a year in the premises of **FIRST PARTY** on its request, and request to be received 10 days in advance.

Priority

Priority would be given to volunteers and donors of the **FIRST PARTY** while conducting any extension activities like organizing health camps, mega blood donation camps, rallies imparting training on first aid or providing any internships for the students in blood collection and its preservation in the blood banks or carrying out any other humanitarian activities.

The Indian Red Cross Society, Kakinada shall coordinate with the local hospital with regard to supply of blood or any other aid for the students of FIRST PARTY during medical emergencies.

NCC, NSS, Health Club and Red Ribbon Club

The four units of NSS & NCC, Health Club and Red Ribbon Club of PARTY 1 coordinates with Indian Red Cross Society, Kakinada in organizing and conducting health camps. The FIRST PARTY also takes up activities related to motivation of students for blood donation and volunteering during the blood donation camps and whenever emergency arises.

4. TERMS OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The scope of the work of the engagement will be to mutually support each other in exchange of human resources and infrastructure facilities to upgrade the knowledge and skills of the students of Pithapur Rajah's college (Autonomous) Kakinada- 533001, AP.

The scope of work DOES NOT include supply of material, resources and DOES NOT have any monetary commitment unless otherwise both parties further agree to incur financial resource for any common activity as mutually agreed and executed.

1. Roles and responsibilities of FIRST PARTY or PITHAPUR RAJAH'S GOVERNMENT COLLEGE (AUTONOMOUS), KAKINADA

A) The first party shall conduct extension activities and outreach programmes in collaboration with the second party and shall involve the students in the extension activities organized by the SECOND PARTY like special blood donation camps, community health promotion programmes and any other humanitarian work.

B) The FIRST PARTY shall organize blood donation camps in association with Indian Red Cross Society, Kakinada and Govt General Hospital, Kakinada, whenever possible.

B) FIRST PARTY shall invariably form its own Youth Red Cross Unit in the College to work in tandem with the SECOND PARTY

B) FIRST PARTY shall conduct motivation classes/lectures in the college to volunteer for blood donation during the blood donation camps conducted by the SECOND PARTY, in the college premises.

C) The Women Empowerment Cell of the FIRST PARTY shall work in collaboration with the SECOND PARTY in organizing women empowerment related activities.

2.Roles and responsibilities of SECOND PARTY or INDIAN RED CROSS SOCIETY, KAKINADA

A. The **SECOND PARTY** shall update the FIRST PARTY on the events being organized by the SECOND PARTY from time to time and give priority to the students of FIRST PARTY during the conduct of blood donation camps, health camps, social work, or any other humanitarian work.

B. The **SECOND PARTY** shall give priority to the students of FIRST PARTY in providing internship/apprenticeship in the area of medical health care and social work.

C. The **SECOND PARTY** shall provide access to Red Cross Yoga Centre to the students of FIRST PARTY to learn yoga from its experts.

D. The **SECOND PARTY** shall spare the services of its Yoga teachers to teach Yoga to the students of FIRST PARTY.

E. The **SECOND PARTY** shall work in association with the Women Empowerment Cell of the FIRST PARTY in organizing women empowerment related activities in the college.

F. The **SECOND PARTY** shall train the students of FIRST PARTY in dealing with the problems of specially challenged especially visually-challenged and senior citizens.

4. Deliverables and timelines:

Details of the deliverables from both the parties will be worked out separately as per the convenience of both the parties. Postponing or cancellation of programs on genuine grounds will be as per the discretion of both the parties with the prior intimation to the other party.

Credit to any output jointly brought out goes to both the parties. Certificates, promotional materials, backdrops of seminars would carry out the logos and names of both the parties.

5. Commercial terms:

There is no financial commitment from both the parties. However, as when needed subject to financial availability both the parties would share the cost of any activity undertaken.

6. Duration

This MOU shall be valid for the term of three years and it can be further extended/revived after assessment of the effectiveness of the collaboration on mutual need basis.

7. Termination

Parties here to may terminate this MOU at any time by giving either party a written notice of 15 days or settlement of any pending dues against agreed deliverables. Termination shall be without prejudice to rights/remedy available to the parties under terms of this MOU and /or legal rights/remedies as for recovery of charges/fee for services rendered.

8. Amendment

Amendment shall be made to this MOU after negotiation in writing.

9. Confidentiality

Both the parties agree to maintain confidentiality and uphold the integrity of the institution therefore will not divulge any information considered confidential about the two parties.

10. Dispute resolution

Any dispute or differences between the parties arising out of or relating to this MOU will be amicably resolved by consultations between the two parties.

11. Binding obligations

Both the parties agree that with the exception of sections titles, "Duration" , "Termination " " Amendment" "Confidentiality" "dispute resolution" this MOU is not intended to create any legally binding obligations on either Institution, but rather, is intended to facilitate discussions regarding general areas of cooperation.
