REPORT ON STITCHING TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR GIRL STUDENTS

The Women Empowerment Cell of Pithapur Rajah's Government College (A), Kakinada organized stitching training classes for girl students with the objective of promoting self-reliance, skill development and economic empowerment. The programme provided students with an opportunity to acquire practical stitching skills that can be useful for personal needs as well as future livelihood opportunities.

No.of Days: 30

Objectives

1. To develop basic stitching and tailoring skills among girl students.
2. To promote self-confidence and self-reliance.
3. To encourage students to acquire vocational skills.
4. To create awareness about opportunities for earning through tailoring and related activities.
5. To support women empowerment through skill-based education.

30 days stitching classes were conducted for interested girl students of the college. The students were introduced to basic stitching techniques, handling of sewing machines, measurement, cutting and simple garment stitching. Practical demonstrations were given, followed by hands-on practice by the students.

The training was conducted in a friendly and participatory manner. Students actively participated in the sessions and showed considerable interest in learning the techniques.

Outcome: The programme helped the participating students acquire basic stitching skills and increased their confidence in performing simple tailoring activities. The training also created awareness about the importance of vocational skills and their potential to contribute to self-reliance and future livelihood opportunities.
