This collective effort reflected the college's strong commitment to environmental sustainability and social responsibility.
















"P.R. Government College Students Excel in APPGCET 2025 with Top Ranks"







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Physics Lecturer Dr.S.V.G.A.Prasad Honoured with IRSD Excellence in Research and **Development Award 2025"**
