Activity Report – Online Quiz Competition on “Indian National Movement”

Date of Activity: 7th August 2025

Mode: Online (via <https://wayground.com/> – previously Quizizz)

Target Group: B.Sc. Artificial Intelligence, Data Science, and Internet of Things Students

Objective of the Activity:

- To promote awareness and understanding among students about India's freedom struggle and national leaders.
- To encourage participation in online learning-based competitive activities.
- To blend digital learning tools with co-curricular engagement in alignment with **NAAC's Quality Initiatives**.
- To develop students' interest in historical and national heritage through an interactive online platform.

About the Activity:

The **Department of Computer Science**, Pithapur Rajah's Government College (Autonomous), organized an **Online Quiz Competition on “Indian National Movement”** on **7th August 2025**. The quiz was conducted on **Wayground (formerly Quizizz)** — a digital platform that allows live, interactive quizzes and instant result analytics.

The competition was open to **B.Sc. Artificial Intelligence, Data Science, and Internet of Things** students. A total of **45 students** participated actively from their respective devices.

The quiz covered 40 objective-type questions focusing on the **Indian National Movement**, including the contributions of key leaders, revolutionary movements, acts passed by the British, and important freedom struggle events. Examples of questions included:

- “Who said, *Swaraj is my birth right and I shall have it?*”
- “Who founded the Forward Bloc Party in 1939?”
- “Who gave the slogan *Inquilab Zindabad?*”
- “Who attended the Parliament of Religions at Chicago in 1893?”

The event aimed to make history learning interactive and engaging through technology-based participation.

- The online quiz encouraged **digital participation, self-evaluation, and quick analytical thinking**.
- The event successfully integrated **ICT-enabled learning** into co-curricular activities, fulfilling NAAC's emphasis on technology-assisted pedagogy.
- Students gained deeper appreciation for the **nationalistic spirit and heritage of India**.
- The activity promoted **competitive learning and enthusiasm for history** among technology-focused students.
