#### Report on Educational Tour to Visakhapatnam

#### **OBJECTIVE:**

The Educational tour to Andhra University – Department of English, Dr.V.S.Krishna Library,INS Kursura Submarine Museum and TU 142 Aircraft Museum was designed to offer the students valuable exposure to academic institutions and historical sites, enhancing both their academic knowledge and cultural awareness.

#### **REPORT:**

On 22nd of March 2025, an enriching educational tour was organized by the Department of English, Pithapur Rajah's Government College (A), Kakinada, to Visakhapatnam for the students of B.A Special English and M.A English. The I, II B.A Special English (Honours) students and III EEP and HEJ students and M.A English Final students were part of this tour. 63 students were part of this tour and they were accompanied by 5 Faculty.

The journey began early in the morning at 5:30 A.M. The Department of English has arranged 2 buses. The first bus has a capacity of 40 and 43 students and 3 Faculty were seated in the first bus. The second bus has a capacity of 20 and 20 students and 2 faculty were seated in the second bus. The students, along with the accompanying faculty, were eager to explore new educational horizons and gain insights into diverse fields of learning. The atmosphere on the bus was filled with excitement as the group made its way to Visakhapatnam.

The first stop of the tour was Andhra University, one of the prestigious educational institutions in the state. The students visited the Department of English at 11.00 A.M. This department is known for its academic excellence, and our students had the opportunity to interact with Assistant Professor Solomon Benny and learnt about the various academic programs. He encouraged the Final Year students to write AP PG CET exam and study Post Graduation in Andhra University.

In the interaction with Assistant Professor Soloman Benny, he emphasised that Andhra University has several foreign students and this multicultural environment helps them in their careers. The visit provided the students with a deeper understanding of the employment opportunities available after completing their Post-Graduation in English which complemented their ongoing studies at our college. The students had their lunch at 1.00 P.M in the afternoon in the vicinity of the Department of English, Andhra University.

Following the academic visit, the group proceeded to Dr. V.S. Krishna Library Andhra University at 2.00 P.M. This library is one of the largest in the region and boasts an

extensive collection of books and journals, particularly in the fields of literature, science, and social sciences. The students were given a guided tour of the library, where they learned about the importance of libraries in higher education and research.

Assistant Librarian showed the copy of the Constitution of India which contained the signatures of Stalwarts like Jawaharlal Nehru, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar and Dr. Rajendra Prasad. Assistant Librarian showed some old manuscripts and palm leaf writings and explained that they belonged to late 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> Centuries. Students also visited the journals and Newspaper section. The students were fascinated by the facilities of the Library and expressed their interest in utilizing such resources for their future academic endeavours.

The next leg of the tour was a visit to two prominent museums in Visakhapatnam: the INS Kursura Submarine Museum and TU 142 Aircraft Museum at 3.30 P.M. Students explored various sections of the INS Kursura submarine, including the engine room, torpedo compartment, and control room. At the INS Kursura Museum, the students were introduced to the fascinating history of the Indian Navy and the role of submarines in maritime defence. Students learned about the history of INS Kursura, including its notable missions during the 1971 Indo-Pakistan war. The students were amazed at the opportunity to explore a real submarine, understanding its functionality and significance in naval operations.

TU 142 Aircraft Museum, located nearby, offered a unique opportunity to witness various aircraft used by the Indian Air Force, as well as detailed exhibits on aviation history. Students explored TU-142 aircraft, where they had the chance to explore various sections of the aircraft, such as the cockpit, cabin, and the flight control areas. They also learned about the strategic importance of having such an advanced aircraft for maintaining national security. These visits proved to be highly educational, broadening the students' knowledge of India's defence services and technological advancements.

The educational tour concluded with the return journey to Kakinada at 5.30 P.M and the students had their dinner enroute to Kakinada. The students and faculty members had a long but fulfilling day, enriched by the experiences and knowledge gained from the visit.

#### **OUTCOME:**

The trip provided a unique opportunity for students to apply theoretical knowledge from their English studies to real-world contexts. By visiting Dr. V.S. Krishna Library in Andhra University students were able to connect their academic learning with the intellectual environment of a university and library that plays a pivotal role in fostering research.

The INS Kursura Museum and TU-142 Aircraft Museum allowed the students to delve into the historical and technological aspects of India's defence forces. These visits highlighted the importance of military history and its cultural relevance, showing students how literature and history can coexist to shape national identity.

Apart from the academic benefits, the trip facilitated personal growth by promoting teamwork, curiosity, and an appreciation for different domains of knowledge. Students had the opportunity to interact with experts and reflect on their experiences in a way that enhanced their intellectual maturity.

Overall, the educational tour to Visakhapatnam was a successful endeavour, providing the students with both academic and practical insights. The tour facilitated intellectual growth, cultural exposure, and a deeper appreciation for the role of history, literature, and technology in shaping our world. 


