## A Brief Report on "Dr. Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar Javanthi"

Dr. Ambedkar was a social reformer, jurist, economist, author, polyglot (knowing or using several languages) orator, a scholar and thinker of comparative religions. He is known as the Father of the Indian Constitution and was India's first Law Minister. He was the Chairman of the Drafting Committee for the new Constitution. He was a well-known statesman who fought for the rights of the Dalits and other socially backward classes.

Session concluded with vote of thanks by M. Venkateswara rao (HOD, PS)









Students performed patriotic songs, skits on Sardar Patel's life.


#### **Conclusion:**


## Report on 76th Republic Day Celebration


