

## Conclusion





World AIDS Day, observed every year on **1 December**, is a global health initiative that aims to spread awareness about HIV/AIDS, remember those who lost their lives, and show support to people living with HIV. It unites communities, governments, and organizations to fight stigma and promote education. Each year, a theme is chosen to guide awareness programs.

## **HISTORY OF WORLD AIDS DAY**

- Started in **1988**, making it the first-ever global health day.
- Initiated by **James Bunn and Thomas Netter** from the World Health Organization (WHO).
- First theme: **Communication**.
- Recent themes focus on equality, awareness, and empowering communities.

## **WHAT IS HIV?**

**HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus)** is a virus that attacks the immune system, especially CD4 cells. If untreated, it gradually weakens the body's ability to fight infections.

## **WHAT IS AIDS?**

**AIDS (Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome)** is the advanced stage of HIV infection. Not everyone with HIV develops AIDS if they receive proper treatment.

## **HOW HIV ATTACKS THE BODY (SIMPLE EXPLANATION)**

- HIV enters the body.
- It targets CD4 cells (helper T-cells).
- The virus multiplies inside these cells.
- CD4 count decreases → immunity falls.
- Body becomes vulnerable to infections.

## **MODES OF TRANSMISSION**

- HIV spreads through:
  - Unprotected sexual contact
  - Sharing infected needles or razors
  - Mother-to-child (pregnancy, delivery, breastfeeding)
  - Transfusion of contaminated blood
  - Unsafe medical procedures

## **HOW HIV DOES NOT SPREAD**

- Hugging / touching
- Kissing
- Sharing food, water, or clothes
- Mosquito bites
- Toilets / swimming pools
- Coughing / sneezing

## **STAGES OF HIV INFECTION**

- Acute HIV Infection – flu-like symptoms
- Chronic HIV Infection – latency period
- AIDS Stage – CD4 count falls below 200  
(Suggested diagram: Simple timeline)

## **DIAGNOSIS & TESTS**

- ELISA Test
- PCR Test
- Rapid Finger-prick Test
- CD4 Cell Count  
Regular testing helps early detection and treatment.

## **TREATMENT (ART – Antiretroviral Therapy)**

- ART reduces the viral load.
- Helps people live long, healthy lives.
- Prevents the virus from multiplying.
- Must be taken daily without missing doses.



The **Elite Anti-Narcotics Group for Law Enforcement (EAGLE)** is a specialized police unit established by the state governments of **Andhra Pradesh** and **Telangana** in India to combat the cultivation, trafficking, and abuse of narcotic drugs.

#### Overview and Objectives

The primary objective of EAGLE is to make the states drug-free by implementing stringent enforcement measures, conducting thorough investigations, and running extensive public awareness campaigns. The group works closely with national agencies like the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB), the Railway Protection Force (RPF), and local police units to coordinate efforts.

Key objectives and functions include:

- **Eradication of Supply:** Targeting the cultivation, production, smuggling, sale, and transportation of narcotic substances, including ganja (cannabis) and synthetic drugs.
- **Enforcement & Investigation:** Registering and investigating cases under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, 1985, and using robust methods like financial analysis and asset seizures to dismantle drug networks.
- **Awareness & Prevention:** Conducting awareness drives in educational institutions and communities to educate youth and parents about the dangers of substance abuse and promote a drug-free lifestyle.
- **Technical Support:** Utilizing a technical wing for surveillance, digital forensics, social media monitoring, and darknet operations to track offenders.

#### Structure and Operations

EAGLE is headed by an officer of Additional Director General of Police (ADGP) or Inspector General of Police (IGP) rank and operates under the overall supervision of the state's Director General of Police.

Key operational features:

- **Headquarters:** The headquarters for Andhra Pradesh EAGLE are in Amaravati, with a narcotics police station and 26 District Narcotics Control Cells (DNCC) across all districts.
- **Personnel:** The unit comprises around 459 personnel, including officers and staff recruited on a deputation basis, who receive specialized training and a special allowance.
- **Special Courts:** The establishment of five special or fast-track courts has been proposed in key cities (Visakhapatnam, Rajamahendravaram, Vijayawada, Guntur, and Tirupati) to expedite legal proceedings in drug cases.
- **Helpline:** A toll-free helpline number (**1972** in Andhra Pradesh, **1908** in Telangana) has been established to ensure informant confidentiality and facilitate public cooperation in reporting drug-related activities.

## Awareness Program on “Say No to Drugs & Alcohol – Cycle Rally”

### Introduction

Drug and alcohol abuse is a major social issue affecting youth, families, and society. To prevent young people from falling into addiction, awareness programs are essential. As a part of this a special **Cycle Rally** programme conducted by the police department, educational institutions, and NSS, NCC volunteers to spread awareness about the dangers of intoxication.

### Detailed Description of the Event

- The cycle rally was held as part of the “**Drive Against Drugs**” campaign.
- A large number of participants, including **students, police officers, NSS, NCC volunteers, teachers, and the public**, took part.
- The rally passed through important routes in the town to reach maximum people.
- Participants rode bicycles holding awareness placards and posters with messages like:



- Gained practical experience in community service


### **Learning Experience**


