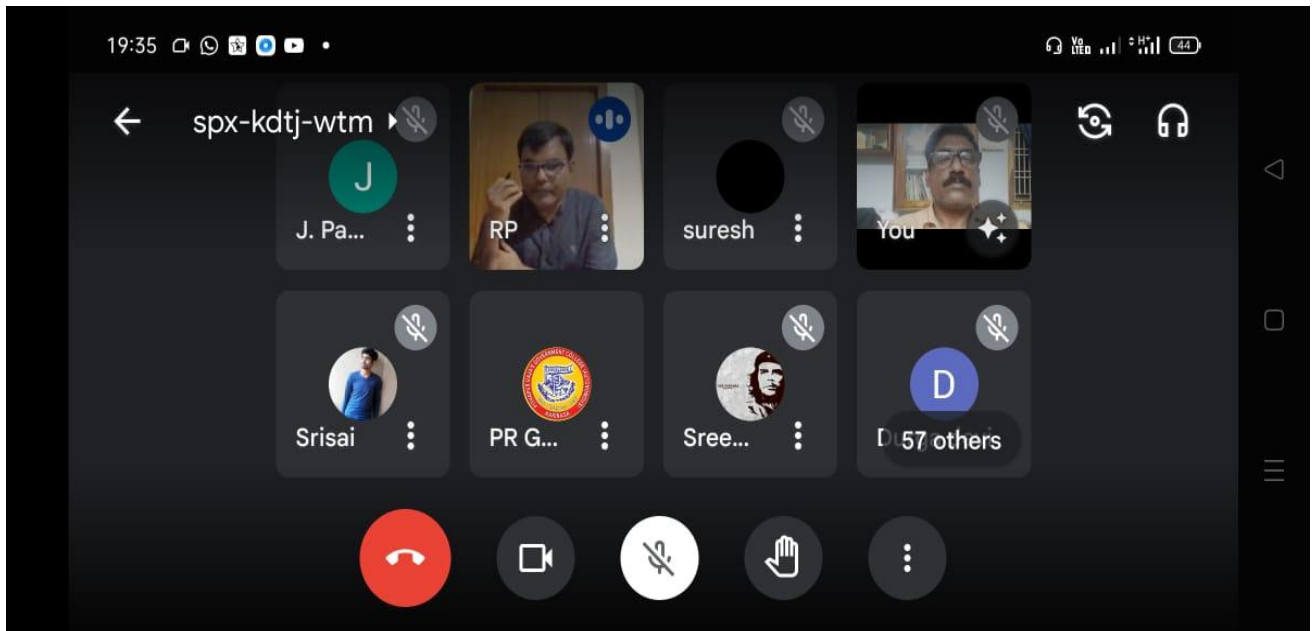
Participation of Economics Students in State level Colloquium

Students of various departments viz. BA, B.Sc and B.Com actively participated in the Student talk. At the end winners were announced.

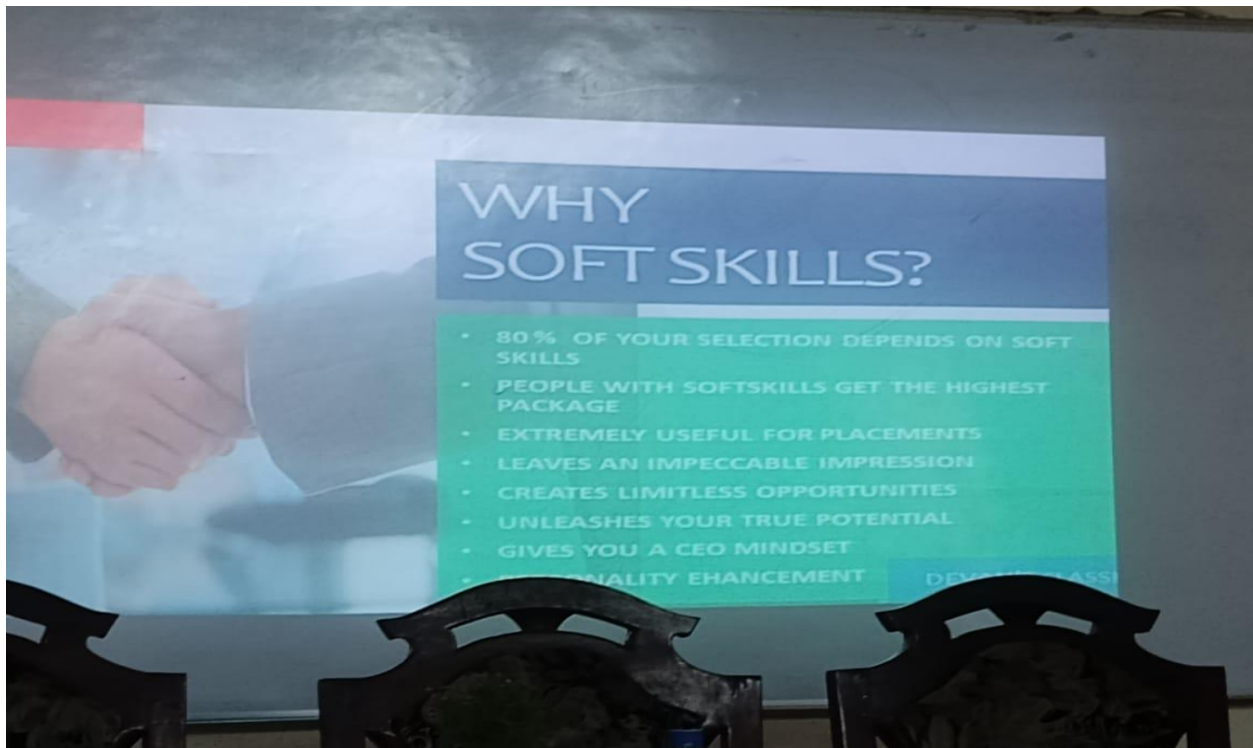
Harivillu Program

On 11th March, 2022 Department of Economics has arranged Assembly Budget Session direct relay to the students of Economics for the understanding of the budgetary procedures.

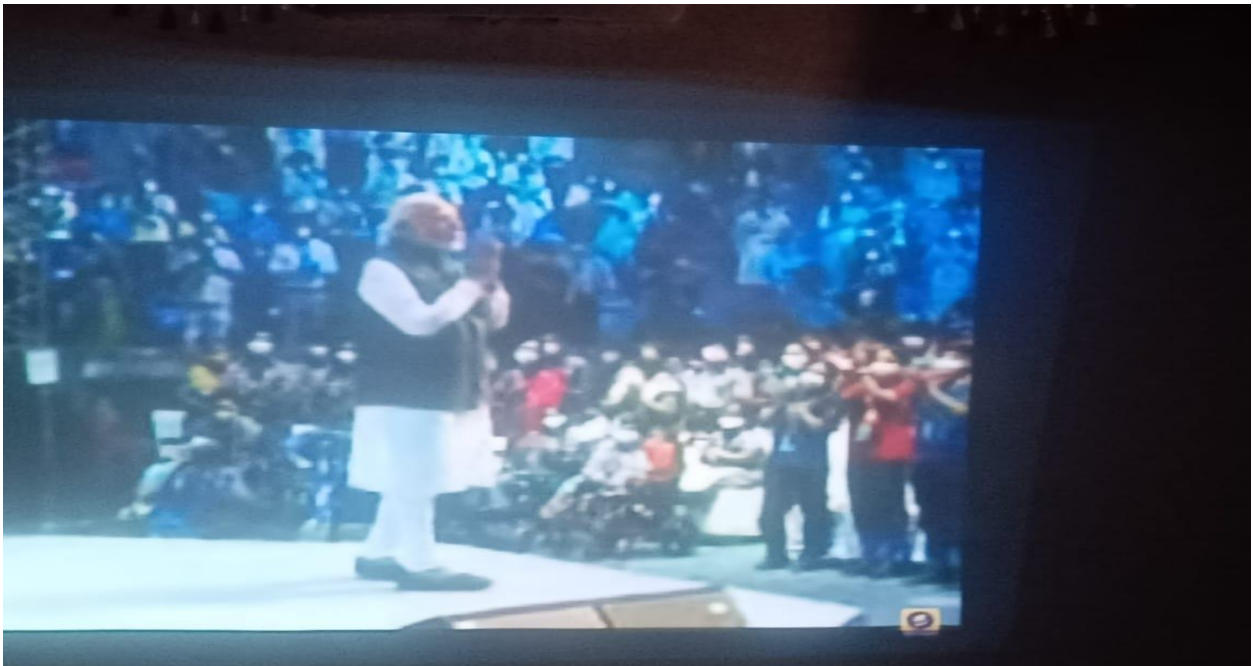
Mock Parliament

Guest Lecture on Planning



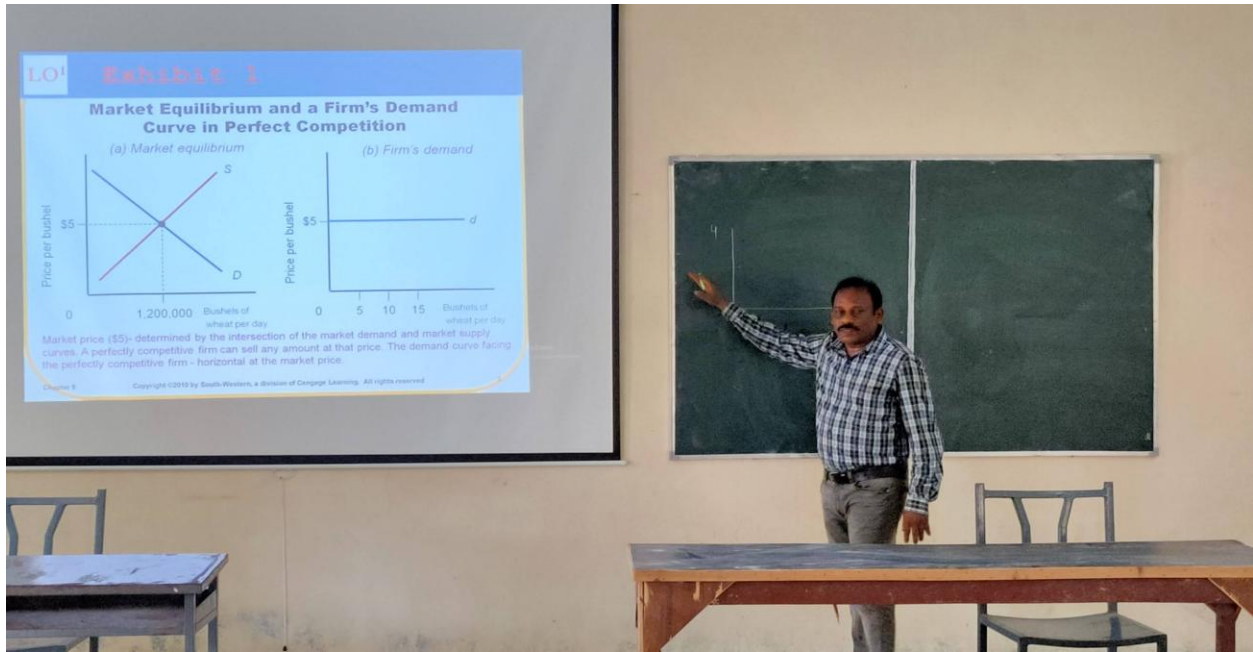
